TROLLEY SYSTEM



When a dog's restraint is attached to a trolley system along a running line.

CAMPING



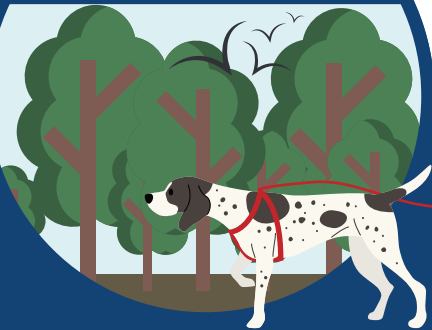
When in a public campground/ other recreational areas.

HERDING/ FARMING



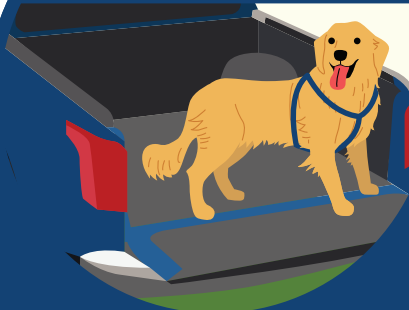
When herding livestock, or assisting with farming tasks.

HUNTING



When hunting or field trialing.

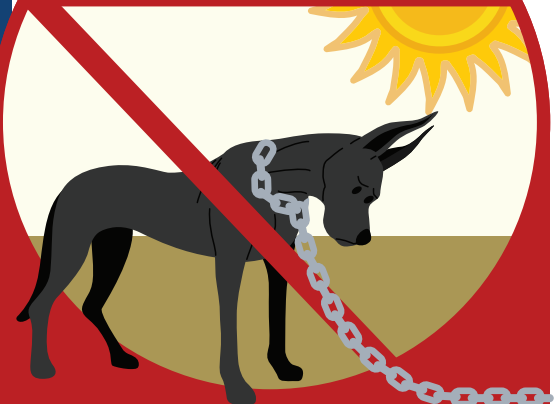
TRUCK BED



While traveling or while temporarily unattended in the back of a truck.
