Sky view of the SRA Pier in the upper Galveston Bay



September 14, 2021 Tropical Storm Nicholas intensified by 35 mph just before landfall and was upgraded to a Category 1 hurricane. Hurricane Nicholas produced maximum sustained winds of 75 mph. These winds and the repeated battering of the waves resulted in damage to our pier. The initial damage assessment reveals most of the damage occurring from the pier landing to the first T-head or approximately 340 feet of decking with a 6 foot width. Also, the first T-head will need new supports and decking for its dimension of 90 feet by 12 feet. Please see photo below.



Several pier building contractors have presented quotes to repair the entire length of the pier at 640 feet. These quotes range from \$95,000 to \$136,500. Clear Choice Contractors also presented a quote for a partial repair up to the broken pilings.

Our dilemma on taking any action is our financial resources. The SRA is funded by membership fees only. Approximately \$20,000 is collected each year in July. We can only allocate about \$15,000 to the repairs and the difference goes to operating expenses. If \$15,000 could get 60-90 feet of the pier repaired, then our goal is \$35-50,000 in order to get the first 340 feet and T-head repaired.



Thus, our current plan of action is to repair approximately 75 feet of pier beginning at the concrete slab (see photo above). SRA is contracting Brad Holloway to perform the repairs and has agreed to start July 18, 2022. Time for completion is no later than July 22, 2022, barring any unforeseeable events. Following this section being repaired, a financial assessment will be conducted to estimate the amount of pier that can be designated for repair. We are hopeful the SRA membership maintains its level of support and pledges for donations are forthcoming so that can incrementally reach the first T-head.
