DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreacres, in the County of Harris County, Texas on the 15th day of July, 2024 , the Mayor has determined that

Hurricane Beryl

Created a disaster, including widespread and severe property damage; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Shoreacres has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF SHOREACRES:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Shoreacres pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

2. Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of Shoreacres.

3. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

4. Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster that activates the City Emergency Management Plan.

5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
